Sustainable CSL integration requires a systemic approach

Best practices for sustainable CSL

 Embed CSL into curricula through modular or credit-bearing structures

 Develop strategic partnerships with businesses, NGOs, and public institutions

 Use technology and micro-credentials to document competences

 Promote reflective practice as a central learning component

 Support faculty development in experiential and reflective pedagogies

 Ensure continuous assessment and feedback

Phase 1 — Strategic planning and stakeholder engagement



Conduct institutional needs assessments.



Align CSL objectives with strategic goals.



Secure leadership and policy-level commitment.



Embed CSL into quality assurance and accreditation thinking.



Build awareness among faculty, employers, and students.

Phases 2–4 — Integration, expansion and evaluation

Phase 2

Piloting & professional development

1. Introduce pilot CSL projects in selected courses
2. Provide professional development for educators
3. Create peer-learning opportunities
4. Document lessons learned
5. Disseminate good practices internally

Phase 3

Scaling & formalisation

1. Embed CSL across study programmes and departments
2. Formalize external partnerships through agreements
3. Create sustainable funding streams
4. Provide incentives for CSL initiatives
5. Expand opportunities for students across disciplines

Phase 4

Monitoring & policy learning

1. Monitor and evaluate CSL outcomes
2. Use student, faculty, and partner feedback
3. Adjust curricula and institutional policies
4. Share results with national and European networks
5. Contribute to policy learning
